Thermo-Lag 330-1 Fire Barriers

Boston Edison Company does not use Thermo-Lag 330-1 fire barrier material at the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station (PNPS). This information was provided in our July 10, 1992, response to NRC Bulletin 92-01, "Failure of Thermo-Lag 330 Fire Barrier System". The NRC acknowledged our response to Bulletin 92-01 and closed the issue for Pilgrim in a letter dated July 15, 1992 (TAC#M83914).

Since Thermo-Lag 330 is not used at PNPS, no further responses are necessary for Items 2, 3, and 4 of the Reporting Requirements of Generic Letter 92-08.
