By letters dated October 28, 2019 and October 29, 2019, VHS Children's Hospital of Michigan, Inc. submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a request for consent to a direct license transfer of NRC Materials License No. 21-03298-06 to Karmanos Cancer Center. Based on the information provided, we understand that this transfer will not result in any change to the licensed materials, personnel, location of use of licensed material, or the Radiation Safety Officer responsible for the oversight of the licensee's radiation safety program.

By letter dated October 29, 2019, Karmanos Cancer Center provided financial assurance information in accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) 30.35. Please provide financial assurance instruments within 30 days of the date of the license transfer in accordance with guidance in NUREG 1757, Volume 3, Revision 1, available at <https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1757/v3/>.

Based on the above understandings and as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff's Safety Evaluation Report which documents the NRC staff's review of the request, we have no objection to the transfer of License No. 21-03298-06.


