SUBJECT: Submittal of Annual Radioactive Effluent Release Reports

In Reference 2, Omaha Public Power District (OPPD) submitted a supplement to an Application for Amendment to revise reporting requirements contained in the Fort Calhoun Station Unit No. 1 Technical Specifications. The proposed change reflects a recent rule change to 10 CFR 50.36a which revised the frequency of submitting radioactive effluent release reports from semi-annually to annually. Subsequent to the submittal, the NRC staff requested that a 90 day time limit be imposed on submitting the subject annual report. OPPD agrees to incorporate the 90 day time limit. To avoid a delay in approval of the pending application, OPPD will commit to incorporate this change in a future Application for Amendment to be submitted by July 1, 1993.
