Decontamination liability, decommissioning liability and excess property damage insurance is also provided by Nuclear Electric Insurance Limited ("NEIL") Policy No. X92-014. The effective recovery limit under this policy, effective November 15, 1992, is \$1.325 billion in excess of \$1.3 billion.
