Supplemental Reply to a Notice of Violation 92-15-06

Gentlemen:

On June 19, 1992, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued a Notice of Violation as part of NRC Inspection Report 50-325/92-15 and 50-324/92-15. By letter dated August 3, 1992, Carolina Power & Light Company responded to the Notice of Violation. The purpose of this letter is to provide the status of the corrective action being taken to address the root cause of the cited failure to include specified components in the second ten-year ISI program interval.

As stated in the original violation response, the root cause of the violation was management's failure to establish appropriate standards for the project or to provide proper resources. The stated corrective action was to develop a standard(s) which defines and establishes controls for complex programs, including review requirements; and to perform a review of existing programs to determine which would be subject to the standards. CP&L's review of this item indicates that a generic "standard document" would not appropriately address standards for specific programs as intended. The implementation of the Brunswick Three-Year Plan and the associated initiatives TY201, Effective Performance Management/Total Quality, and TY303, Improve Ability to Identify and Correct Problems, will address the cause of this violation. These actions should result in better communication of expectations, critical evaluations of the adequacy of BNP processes and products by managers and staff, and appropriate provision of resources to the programs identified in the plan as initiatives or process improvements. This letter revises the response to the referenced violation consistent with the above.
