Southern Nuclear Organizational Change

On September 18, 1992, Georgia Power Company submitted proposed amendments to Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-57 and NPF-5 which would authorize Southern Nuclear Operating Company, Inc. (Southern Nuclear) to become the licensed operator and have exclusive responsibility and control over the physical construction, operation, and maintenance of Edwin I. Hatch Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2.

The September 18, 1992 application presented a list of directors and officers for Southern Nuclear as it existed at that time. This list identified Mr. F. D. Kuester as being a Southern Nuclear officer with the title of Assistant Secretary and Assistant Treasurer. Georgia Power Company letter of October 23, 1992 to the NRC provided notification that Mr. F. D. Kuester had been named to a position within Southern Company Services, a separate subsidiary of The Southern Company and that an individual would be named to fill Mr. Kuester's position in the normal course of business.


On February 22, 1993, the Board of Directors of Southern Nuclear elected Mr. J. F. Young to the office of Assistant Secretary and Assistant Treasurer of the Company. Mr. Young is a citizen of the United States and has served in various positions of responsibility for over nine years as an employee of Gulf Power Company, a separate subsidiary of The Southern Company. Mr. Young was recently named vice president, investor relations, at Southern Company Services, with responsibility for operations of the company's investor relations office in New York.

This personnel change has no effect on the organizational chart provided in the application. No other management change was made and all reporting lines specified in the Application to Amend Facility Operating license Nos. DPR-57 and NPF-5 remain the same. This change has no impact on the significant hazards consideration evaluation or the conclusions made in the application.
