
Dear Mr. Repka,

As clearly stated in the San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace Motion for Extension of Discovery Deadline, the "SLOMFP must obtain the response to its other discovery requests in order for the site visit to be useful..." [March 4, 1993] at 1. Based on the information the SLOMFP has received to date, the site inspection will not take place on March 17, 1993, as previously planned.

PG&E's responses to the first set of interrogatories and requests for production of documents filed by SLOMFP [March 10, 1993] were inadequate. They included only responses to Contention V and the vast majority of these responses were simply objections to respond. The SLOMFP understands that the responses to Contention I will arrive Monday morning, March 15. The SLOMFP will not visit the DCNPP for the purpose of a site inspection until it is known what documents will be made available for review and other discovery disputes are resolved.

Individuals from the SLOMFP are still interested in reviewing documents at the site on March 16, 1993, without their consultants, Greg Minor and Steve Sholly. Please add Jill ZamEk to the list of attendees. SS# 549-92-5480; birthdate 4/29/52.
