Gentlemen:

Long Island Power Authority (LIPA) hereby submits notification of organizational changes to the Shoreham Decommissioning Project. These changes are administrative and procedural in nature, do not involve technical or programmatic changes, and are designed to strengthen the organizational ability to manage current and future decommissioning activities.

The changes involve: 1) consolidation of the Nuclear Engineering Division and the Decommissioning Engineering Division. The consolidated division will report to the Decommissioning Department Manager as the Nuclear Engineering Division; 2) deactivation of the Special Process Division of the Decommissioning Department; and 3) transfer of the Fuel Disposition Division from the Nuclear Operations Support Department to the Decommissioning Department.


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A revised LIPA Shoreham Plant Organization Chart has been attached to replace the one previously issued to the Staff in LIPA Response II.(18) of reference (2). The Fuel Disposition Division, not previously addressed in the Decommissioning Plan, is responsible for 1) identifying fuel disposal options to LIPA; 2) project management of any activities involved in developing the options; and 3) implementing the selected option.

This information is being provided to you as part of LIPA's overall commitment to keep the NRC Staff informed on significant organizational changes. Should you have any questions, or require additional information, please do not hesitate to contact me or my staff.
