SEQUOYAH NUCLEAR PLANT (SQN) - TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION (TS) CHANGE 93-04,
ACTION STATEMENT CLARIFICATION FOR CONTAINMENT VACUUM RELIEF PENETRATIONS

Reference: SQN Licensee Event Report 50-327/92015 dated August 27, 1992

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.90, we are enclosing a requested amendment to Licenses DPR-77 and DPR-79 to change the TSs of SQN Units 1 and 2. The proposed change provides a footnote to Action Statement 3.6.3.b and to Table 3.6-2 for considering SQN's vacuum relief valves as deactivated automatic valves. The proposed amendment completes a TVA commitment contained in the referenced licensee event report (LER).

The proposed TS change is identified in Enclosure 1. The justification for the proposed TS change is provided in Enclosure 2. A proposed determination of no significant hazards consideration performed pursuant to 10 CFR 50.92 is provided in Enclosure 3.

The immediate corrective action in the referenced LER involved a temporary compensatory measure that remains in effect for both units. NRC staff review and approval are requested as soon as possible to obviate the need for these compensatory measures. TVA requests a 45-day implementation period for this TS change following issuance.

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
