

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION (TS) NO. 331

As requested by the NRC in a March 29, 1993, teleconference, TVA provides the following clarification to the term "applicable" as used in proposed Technical Specification 6.9.1.7.b and Bases 2.1, Reference 2. TVA interprets "applicable" to mean the latest approved revision of General Electric Licensing Topical report NEDE-24011-P-A at the time the reload analyses are performed for each BFN core design.
