San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace
Motion for Extension of Deadline to
Respond to Memorandum and Order
[Addendum to FES]

On March 24, the San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace ("SLOMFP") received a document from the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board: Memorandum and Order [Addendum to FES] [March 19, 1993]. In this document, the Licensing Board informed the interested parties of the existence of an "Addendum to the Final Environmental Statement for the Operation of the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Plant Units 1 and 2" dated May 1976 ["Addendum"]. Memorandum and Order at 1. The Licensing Board additionally posed two questions to the parties. *Id.* at 2.

On March 25, SLOMFP contacted the Public Document Room ("PDR") in San Luis Obispo and learned that the Addendum could not be located. A librarian in the PDR contacted the NRC Headquarters and it was agreed that the document be shipped to the Public Document Room in San Luis Obispo. As of the morning of April 1, this document has not yet been made available to SLOMFP. According to the Board's Order, SLOMFP's response would be due on Monday, April 5. *Id.* at 2. SLOMFP understands that this document contains approximately 50 pages and assumes that substantial time will be required to read and analyze this material. SLOMFP therefore requests an extension

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of the time to respond to the aforementioned questions until ten days after
SLOMFP receives the Addendum to the FES.
