BRUNSWICK NUCLEAR PLANT THREE-YEAR PLAN (1993-1995)

Dear Mr. Ebner:

This letter submits Carolina Power & Light Company's "Brunswick Nuclear Plant Three-Year Plan (1993-1995)" for the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant, Unit Nos. 1 and 2. Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) and the Brunswick Nuclear Plant (BNP) management team have established goals and objectives for BNP characterized by high standards of performance, site and individual accountability, effective planning, continuous improvement, and people empowerment. The overall objective for the period 1993-1995 is to establish the capability for BNP to achieve "world-class" results. That is, CP&L expects BNP to perform among the top quartile of U.S. nuclear plants in 1996, 1997, and beyond in the areas of safety, operations, and cost performance, and to sustain in that time period significant improvement in the areas of employee satisfaction and schedule and commitment achievement. This is a comprehensive improvement plan for BNP, and it incorporates and supersedes outstanding items from the Integrated Action Plan.

The BNP management team has developed a vision for the plant and the plant organization to be achieved over the next three years. Based on the projected expectations of the customers served by the plant, both internal and external to CP&L, the BNP team has identified the desired results necessary to meet these expectations. Achievement of the results will require certain organizational capabilities. Strategies and associated projects and initiatives are being implemented to develop or enhance these capabilities. The goals, vision, strategies, and associated initiatives and projects are described in the BNP Three-Year Plan, and are integrated with the CP&L Corporate Improvement Initiatives described in our November 30, 1992 submittal.

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
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The Three-Year Plan specifically describes certain key initiatives and projects for BNP that either have already begun or will begin in early 1993 and sets forth the schedule for completing tasks relating to these initiatives. Details of activities and schedules in the plan for 1994 and 1995 are not yet as complete and well defined as for 1993. In September 1993, after progress has been demonstrated, BNP will revise the Three-Year Plan to provide detailed task descriptions and updated schedules for 1994 and 1995. Further, BNP management will closely monitor work under this plan to ensure that the plan is kept up to date and the effort remains focused on achieving the desired results. This will result in periodic changes to the plan, but such changes will be carefully considered before they are made and will be made in accordance with the change process set forth in the plan.

We will keep you and your staff periodically informed on the status of plan initiatives and projects and will discuss with you the establishment of tracking milestones, procedures for assessing our progress in achieving desired results, and other aspects of the plan. We would like to meet with you and your staff at your convenience to discuss these matters.
