Gentlemen:

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(p), Georgia Power Company (GPC) hereby submits the March 1993 revision to the Plant Hatch Nuclear Security Training and Qualification Plan (TQP). With this revision, GPC removed the Safeguards categorization from (declassified) the TQP, because the TQP does not meet the criteria for Safeguards Information specified in 10 CFR 73.21(b). Removing the Safeguards categorization from the TQP requires the entire TQP be removed from the Physical Security Plan (PSP) manual and dispositioned in accordance with 10 CFR 73.21(f)(2). Enclosure 1 lists the specific actions relative to the declassification of the TQP.

Georgia Power Company has determined the revised TQP does not contain information which could be reasonably construed as Safeguards. The information contained in the TQP is generic in nature or exists in the public domain as stated in 10 CFR 73, Appendix B, "General Criteria for Security Personnel."

Each revision to the TQP is indicated by a vertical bar placed in the right margin. The revisions are editorial/administrative in nature and are considered enhancements to the readability and specificity of the document. Terminology was clarified and simplified, as appropriate, and numerous tasks descriptions were revised and/or consolidated to eliminate redundancy and provide more relevant information. The Firearms Qualification Program was revised to reflect current qualification criteria. The comparative analysis of NUREG 0674 and the Hatch TQP was deleted, since the analysis was used as a demonstration matrix during the initial development of the TQP and is no longer essential to the body of the document.

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
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As stated previously, the enclosed information is no longer classified as Safeguards Information and, therefore, can be placed in the Public Document Room.

### Edwin I. Hatch Nuclear Plant Units 1, 2 Nuclear Security Training and Qualification Plan Instructions for Declassification Process

#### Physical Security Plan (PSP)

1. Remove the Nuclear Security Training and Qualification Plan pages, beginning with the cover sheet and ending with page A-10, from the PSP manual and destroy in the same manner you destroy Safeguards Information.
2. Remove the existing manual cover and spine (side insert), and the Distribution List. Insert the enclosed cover and spine, and Distribution List.
3. Sign, date, and return the enclosed Receipt of Acknowledgement, as indicated.

#### TQP

The declassified TQP revisions will be issued in comb binders; therefore, no revision insertion instructions are necessary.
