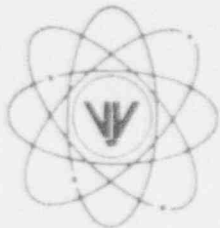

This is to inform you that Vermont Yankee hereby plans to implement the necessary plant modifications to meet the ARI diversity requirements of the ATWS Rule, including the Staff's position Reference (b), regarding diversity of manufacturer, for both the reactor water level and the reactor pressure parameters. Vermont Yankee currently plans to implement these plant modifications no later than the end of the scheduled 1995 refueling outage, presently planned to begin in March, 1995.
