Florida Power Corporation (FPC) has reviewed your letter dated March 31, 1993, summarizing and accepting our responses to NRC Bulletin 92-01, "Failure of Thermo-lag 330 Fire Barrier System to Maintain Cabling in Wide Cable Trays and Small Conduits Free from Fire Damage," and the associated Supplement 1. As a result of document searches and the compilation of information associated with a Federal subpoena on Thermo-lag material, FPC has identified an omission in the information we provided in answer to the subject Bulletin in that one additional use of Thermo-lag material was identified.



Thermo-lag material was used as a three hour barrier on one side of building steel located on the 124' elevation of the Control Complex. The building steel rests on top of three hour fire barrier concrete walls and forms the upper connection to the next elevation's floor. This use of Thermo-lag material was overlooked during reviews in preparation for the response to Supplement 1 of the Bulletin. The one hour roving fire watches originally established in response to the Bulletin have included this area from the onset, therefore, no new compensatory measures were required.




