Subject: Change to Commitment Made to the NRC

In Reference 3, Detroit Edison made the following
commitment:

"... no more than one sixth of I&C personnel will be
scheduled for continuing I&C training at one time.
This will ensure sufficient manpower for support of
plant equipment including the security equipment."

This commitment was made to assure the NRC that adequate
resources would be available to maintain security equipment.

One result of the recent reorganization at Fermi 2 is that
the I&C group will no longer be divided into six groups.
Detroit Edison desires to change the commitment made in
Reference 3 to state that adequate I&C resources will be
available to maintain plant equipment including security
equipment. This meets the intent of the commitment.

Discussion concerning this issue was held on April 29 between
Messrs. Robert Newkirk and John Tibai of Nuclear Licensing
and Mr. Monte Phillips of your staff.


