On April 23, 1993, Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") filed a Motion to Impose Duty on MFP to Supplement Responses to Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents. PG&E expresses its frustrations with the San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace ("SLOMFP") responses to PG&E's Second Set of Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents. SLOMFP hereby responds to PG&E.

SLOMFP is aware of its duty to supplement its answers to discovery requests, yet SLOMFP cannot answer what it does not know. Working within the compressed time schedule of the discovery period, working with limited resources, and busy with the issues that have come up in the course of discovery, SLOMFP has not had the opportunity to evaluate the case. Furthermore, SLOMFP has not yet received all of the information and documents requested of PG&E. SLOMFP would hope to be allowed the time to evaluate its case. SLOMFP is working with its consultants and would expect to be able to identify its expert witnesses prior to summary disposition.

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
