

Organizational Changes

On Monday, May 3, 1993, The Southern Nuclear Operating Company (SNC) Board of Directors elected Mr. W. G. Hairston, III President, Chief Operating Officer, and member of the Board of Directors, effective immediately. As the company's president, Mr. Hairston succeeds Mr. R. P. McDonald, who retires June 1, 1993, upon customary retirement. Mr. McDonald was named SNC Chairman of the Board and will remain SNC's Chief Executive Officer until his retirement. Mr. Hairston's successor for his prior position at SNC will be named in the normal course of business.

The Board of Directors also announced that Mr. H. A. Franklin, President and Chief Executive Officer of Southern Company Services (SCS), will succeed Mr. R. P. McDonald as SNC Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer upon his retirement. Mr. Franklin will assume his new duties in addition to his responsibilities at SCS.
