RE: Request for Extension to Provide a Revised HMC Response to NRC's "Request for Additional Information – Compliance of Homestake Grants, New Mexico Site with 10 CFR 20.1301 and 10 CFR 20.1302." Docket No. 040-08903, License No. SUA-1471

Dear Mr. Linton:

As discussed January 9, 2020 on a phone conference between the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and Homestake Mining Company of California (HMC), HMC believes that without an amendment to license condition 10 (LC-10) to change the location of the background radon monitoring station (currently station HMC-16), HMC cannot adequately address the 10 CFR 20.1301 public dose RAI as cited above in a manner consistent with NRC's Interim Staff Guidance DUWP-ISG-01 entitled "*Evaluations of uranium recovery facility surveys of radon and radon progeny in air and demonstrations of compliance with 10 CFR 20.1301*" (NRC, 2019).

Therefore, HMC requests an extension to provide a response to NRC's request for additional information pending further discussion on the scheduled phone call 13Feb2020; **RE: Rn Public Dose Clarification Discussion**, between NRC and HMC. Also, an amendment to LC-10, re-location of the background radon monitoring station is planned to be submitted to NRC by 31Mar2020.
