Dear Sirs;

I am a junior at Brunswick High School and very much concerned over the Davis-Besse Atomic Power Plant now being constructed on Lake Erie. Brunswick, being close to Lake Erie and consequently, the plant, makes my anxiety over this structure even more intense. The building of atomic power plants all over the U.S. should be of major concern to all of us, and the recent construction of the Davis-Besse Atomic Power Plant has brought this very serious issue to my attention and concern.

I am surely not one to "stand in the way of progress" but my idea of progress is not allowing an atomic plant to be built which will be subjecting human beings to radiation and its genetic effects, no matter how important this plant is to atomic research and development. Some people would probably say then, that this means no atomic plants should be constructed. Because all expose a certain

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amount of radiation. But I am only saying that until more advanced health measures against radiation are in effect, the construction and progress of these plants should be delayed. And I believe the Daves Bess Atomic Power Plant is a good one to start with. Not only should more advanced health measures against radiation be affected for the surrounding cities and their population, but also for the employees who will be working in these plants and subjected to an even greater amount of rods of radiation, possibly 10 times the amount exposed to the outside world.
