## Edison A-Plant

### Plan Attacked

#### Thermal Pollution Of Lake Is Feared

WASHINGTON (AP) — A \$240 million nuclear generating plant proposed for the shores of Lake Erie in Ottawa County fails to include proper safeguards against thermal pollution, Rep. Joseph P. Vigorito (D., Pa.) said today.

Mr. Vigorito referred in a statement to the application of Toledo Edison Co. and Cleveland Electric Illuminating Co. to build the facility.

"Any thermal pollution of Lake Erie off the Ohio shoreline will ultimately have adverse effects to the portions of the lake off Pennsylvania and New York," Mr. Vigorito said.

"I don't think we should sit idly by and see Presque Isle beaches ruined because of what happens in Cleveland and Toledo," he said.

His reference was to the Interior Department's order for hearings on water pollution charges against three major steel companies in Cleveland and the city of Toledo.
