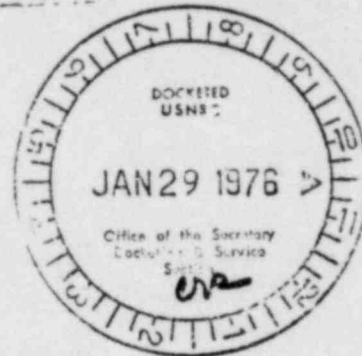

Sanders and Dempsey, 630 Bulkley Building, Cleveland, Ohio 44115, request that this subpoena be quashed or modified if it is unreasonable or requires evidence not relevant to any matter in issue in this proceeding. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission may condition its denial of such a motion to quash or modify this subpoena on just and reasonable terms.

Further, pursuant to Section 2.720(c), you are entitled upon service of this subpoena to a tender of fees and mileage payable to witnesses in District Courts of the United States.
