TO THE NUCLEAR SAFETY & LICENSING APPEALS BOARD:

Pursuant to CFR 2.762, I am filing an appeal of the Board's initial ruling on my contention 6. I contend the Board made an error in fact when it ruled that a marine biomass farm is not a reasonable and feasible alternative to CNGS. Specifically, the Board erred when it ruled that the Applicant's "expert", Dr. Woodcock, showed that a test farm deployed in Sept. 1978 off the California coast could not be classified as prototype marine biomass farm, and it erred when it ruled the same Dr. Woodcock proved marine biomass production could not be put in use within forty years. I shall submit a brief detailing the errors in these rulings.


