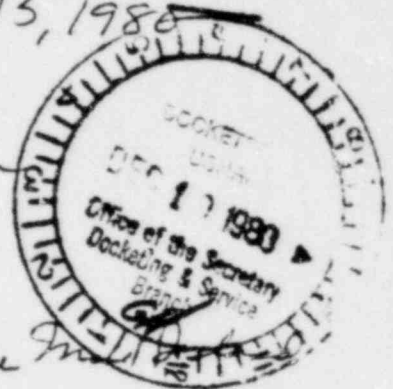

Dear Commissioner Ahearne:



Since Unit No. 1 on Three Mile Island  
belonging to General Public Utilities was not  
damaged in the accident involving Unit  
No. 2 and it is similar in design and  
operation to other units that are apparently  
operating safely in other parts of the Country  
please advise as to the justification  
the Nuclear Regulatory Commission believes  
it has for the prolonged delay of a restart.

It must be recognized that the  
protracted delay is causing a loss of  
Confidence by many investors in the entire  
spectrum of Utility companies and will  
cause investment Capital to be available  
at only the most exorbitant rates.  
Consumers and investors alike deserve  
to hear a complete explanation of your  
action together with your assessment  
of the positive and negative consequences.  
I am hoping for an early  
optimistic reply.
