Delay in the restart of Unit 1 at Three Mile Island seems difficult to understand.

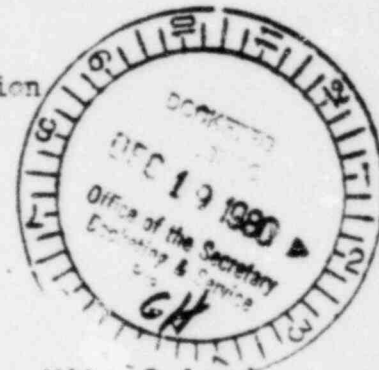
