Dear Chairman Ahearne,

I am writing in regards to the Unit I start up hearings. I feel very strongly that Unit I should be allowed to restart again soon. I feel Unit I is being discriminated against all other reactors in the U.S. They are allowed to be kept operating while modifications are made but Unit I has been shut down.

I feel because it sits beside damaged Unit II. In its 5 years of operation, Unit I had one of the top performance records in the nation. If Unit I were allowed to restart today, consumers would be saved \$150 million per year in power replacement costs. If a customer's bill is \$100 per month, he would save about \$17.00 per month with Unit I restarted. In this inflationary time that is quite a lot of money to most

families. For these reasons and others, I feel Unit I should be allowed to protest immediately. I would appreciate if you could keep me update on the Unit I hearings outcome.
