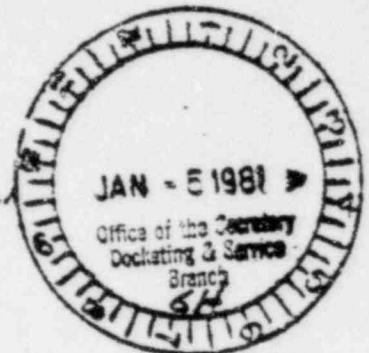

Dear Mr. Ahearn:

We are totally in favor of the immediate restart of TH1 Unit No. 1. Your prompt response to this request will greatly enhance the local, state and national economy. All of the customers including industry served by this unit are saddled with unnecessarily high electric bills which greatly effects our competitive edge and the unemployment in the area.

The continued delay in returning this unit to service has also perpetuated the burning of large quantities of oil to replace a portion of the energy previously supplied by this unit. This oil should be conserved for use in other areas where viable substitutes are not yet practical.

Politics should be put aside in favor of the well being of the people and our nation. We believe there have been enough polls and votes on the subject of nuclear energy to show that the majority of the people favor nuclear power. A goodly portion of the rest of the developing world is proceeding with nuclear power as rapidly as possible, so what purpose can be served by us slowing down or stopping. If we continue this reluctance to proceed with developing our nuclear energy resources we will become a second rate nation which would require many generations to recover if at all. Our participation in the development, design, manufacture and construction management of nuclear energy resources will be taken over by other nations. This will result in greater balance of payment deficits and further loss of employment, particularly in the professional and highly skilled areas.

Your prompt attention to this urgent matter of returning Unit No. 1 to service will be good for all and greatly appreciated by us.
