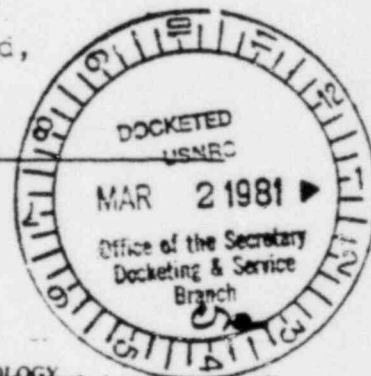
Dear Chairman Bowers,
