I believe Unit 1 of Three Mile Island should never be restarted. It is too close to Reactor 2, the company is too careless.

I think it is a crime that our tax money has been stolen for years to subsidize nuclear power. Otherwise we would now have solar heated buildings and solar produced electricity. The proposed increase in nuclear support and abandoning the Solar-Conservation of energy bank before it starts are the reverse of the way we should go.

A Solar conference in 1962 or 63 pointed out that the benefit of nuclear power had been greatly exaggerated, that solar methods were possible, workable in the 1960's and much less dangerous to present and future generations.
