SUBJECT: PROMPT NOTIFICATION IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY

Dear Mr. Tedesco:

In response to your letter of July 20, 1981, same subject, TUGCO hereby confirms that a prompt notification system will be installed for CPSES in accordance with the requirements of 10CFR50, Appendix F, Section IV.D.3. We are presently evaluating alternative means of meeting this requirement. We expect to make a decision on selection of a system by the first quarter of 1982 and will have developed by that time, a specific schedule for engineering, procurement, and installation. The system will be installed in a timely manner to support the expected FEMA review during the joint exercise of our facility with offsite authorities, prior to issuance of a license for power operation.

We therefore respectfully request an extension of time of six (6) months to provide a description of the system and a schedule for installation.
