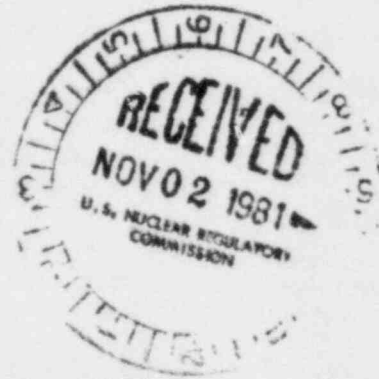

Gentlemen:


Please consider the opinion of one private citizen
