License Condition 33 requires an annual summary of the amount of 11e. (2) byproduct material disposed of from off-site generators to be submitted to the NRC every year. For the year 1994, the total amount of byproduct waste disposed of from Intercontinental Energy Corporation was 6,002,560 pounds or 3,001.28 tons.

Assuming void spaces from contaminated equipment even after dismantling or crushing, Energy Fuels estimates that one ton (2000 pounds) is equivalent to one cubic yard. Thus, approximately, 3,001.28 cubic yards of byproduct waste was disposed in cell 3 in 1994. Attached is Table 1.0, 1994 *Intercontinental Energy Corporation Shipments*, showing the amount of waste disposed on a monthly basis.
