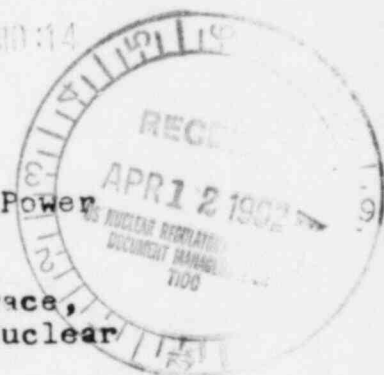

Re: The operation and licensure of Fermi II Nuclear Power
Plant, Monroe, Michigan

As a concerned citizen for the future of the human race,
I strongly urge you to deny licensure to the Fermi Nuclear
Power Plant.

We are constantly being alerted to the life-threatening
dangers created by nuclear power plants in operation. This
was clearly demonstrated by the events at Three Mile Island.

Plutonium, processed from Uranium, has a half life of
24,400 years And is poisonous for at least a half a million
years and is used in making nuclear bombs. The nuclear sew-
age, containing plutonium, is radioactive and corrosive and
cannot be contained in leakproof containers protecting it from
war, earthquakes, floods, and tornadoes. The Savannah River
Nuclear Power Plant may have already polluted 1,000 square
