HARTSVILLE AND PHIPPS BEND NUCLEAR PLANTS - REPORTABLE DEFICIENCY -  
STANDBY GAS TREATMENT SYSTEM CHARCOAL ADSORBER (NCR HTN NEB 80-02  
AND PBN NEB 80-02) - SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT

Initial notification of the subject deficiency was made to NRC-OIE, Region II, Inspector R. W. Wright on May 8, 1980. The revised final report was submitted on December 9, 1981. As discussed with Inspector R. Butcher on April 6, 1982, TVA was unable to meet our corrective action completion date of April 5, 1982. TVA has elected to defer construction activities for these projects. Deferral does not mean that the project will be cancelled, but TVA is minimizing its expenditures and construction efforts until such time that TVA has sufficient information to indicate whether these projects should be completed or cancelled. Therefore, we will not be able to complete corrective action for this nonconformance until a final decision is made regarding these projects. We consider 10 CFR Part 21 applicable to this nonconformance.
