Dear Mr. Tedesco:

As a result of our recent submittal of the subject plan, Mr. Don Perrotti, of your staff, has reviewed the Waterford 3 Emergency Plan against the requirements in Nureg 0654. Mr. Perrotti, in a conversation with our Mr. R. Azzarello on March 26, 1982, identified several areas of the Plan which needed clarification and/or additional information. These areas are discussed below:

Figure 7-11 will be revised to include St. John the Baptist Parish Civil Defense/ Sheriff, St. Charles Parish Emergency Preparedness/ Sheriff, K.T.H. Fire Department, U. S. Coast Guard, and St. Charles, Ochsner, and West Jefferson Hospitals.

B.5

Tab'e 5-1 will include mechanical and electrical maintenance function performed by personnel assigned other duties. Security personnel will also be included as per the Security Plan.

Letters of Agreement with Ebasco, Combustion Engineering, AP&L, M.S.S., and MP&L will be provided.

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
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- B.9 Revised Letters of Agreement with St. Charles, Ochsner, and West Jefferson Hospitals will be provided.
- D.1 and D.2 NRC review is in process.
- F.1 Section 7.5.2 will be revised to include radio communications and designation of primary and backup communication systems.
- G.3.b Revise Section 7.2.2 to include the General Office Information Center as the backup to the Waterford News Center.
- H1, H2, H3, H4 NRC review in progress.
- I.2 Revise Section 7.4 to include post accident sampling capability when information is available.
- J.10.C Section 7.5.4 is presently being developed to give a description of the outdoor warning system which meets the intent of Nureg 0654 Appendix 3.
- K.1 Section 6.5.3 will be revised to include the contamination control measures with regard to food supplies onsite.
- O.4.1 Table 8-1 will be revised to include training of the personnel in the Corporate Command Center.
- P.1 Section 8.3.1 will be revised to clarify the training of the Emergency Planning Coordinator.
- P.3 Section 5 will be revised to include the following responsibilities of the Emergency Planning Coordinator:
- a) Ensuring the coordination and interface of the site plan with state and local plans.
 - b) Ensuring that information and data in the EPIPs are consistent with the emergency Plan.

- c) Ensuring the EIPs are coordinated and interface properly with other procedures.
- d) Assisting the Training Manager - Nuclear in coordinating and/or providing Emergency Plan training.
- e) Maintaining himself current with respect to Federal regulations and guidance that impact emergency planning activities, including appropriate training seminars, etc.
