
CONSUMERS POWER COMPANY'S ANSWER TO THE MOTION BY
SAGINAW VALLEY NUCLEAR STUDY GROUP
TO TERMINATE ORAL ARGUMENT

By Motion served on April 22, 1982, the Saginaw Valley Nuclear Study Group requested the Appeal Board to cancel the oral argument in this matter, now set for May 13, 1982.
