

Dear Administrative Judges:

We have enclosed Consumers Power Company's Response to the NRC Staff Proposed Supplemental Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law for Partial Decision on Quality Assurance and Management Attitude Issues in the above captioned case.

These proposed findings address the quality assurance and management attitude issues raised by the December 6, 1979 Order Modifying Construction Permits and related Contentions of Intervenor Barbara Stamiris. In particular, they involve (1) the National SALP report; (2) the MPQAD modifications; (3) Audit Report F-77-32; and (4) Quality Control Inspector qualifications.
