This is to supplement our February 25, 1982, letter (ØCANØ282Ø9) wherein AP&L committed to the installation of a redundant hydrogen/oxygen analyzing system at ANO. We indicated to you that we were reviewing vendor data with regards to making a final selection as to the type of equipment best suited to our particular needs at ANO, and that we anticipated being in a position by April 30, 1982, to provide NRC with revised Technical Specification changes and a proposed schedule for equipment installation. Because of our prioritizing the workload of our technical staff to fulfill other NRC-related commitments, we now anticipate submitting this information by May 14, 1982.
