## Freedom of Information Act Request


To Whom it May Concern:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 522, as amended, the Coalition for Safe Power requests the following documents regarding Washington Public Power Supply System units 4 and 5, as well as two miscellaneous items.

1. Provide all documents, correspondence and other communication, formal or informal, regarding NRC Staff discussions with WPPSS on the financial ability requirement for units 4 and 5, including discussions of removing this requirement.
2. Provide any documents, correspondence or other communication regarding the possible transfer of licenses for WPPSS 4 and 5 to other owners.
3. Provide any documents, correspondence and other communication regarding the termination of WPPSS units 4 and 5.
4. Provide a copy of the information provided to the Chairman's Office regarding plant cancellations noted in the January 20, 1982 Weekly Information Report for the Commissioners, Enclosure 1.
5. Provide a case study on vessel level instrumentation in boiling water reactors done by the Office for Analysis and Evaluation of Operational Data.

In our opinion, it is appropriate in this case for you to waive copying charges, pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552 (a)(4)(A) "because furnishing the information can be considered as primarily benefitting the general public." The Coalition for Safe Power is a non-profit public interest organization working on energy issues since 1970.
