

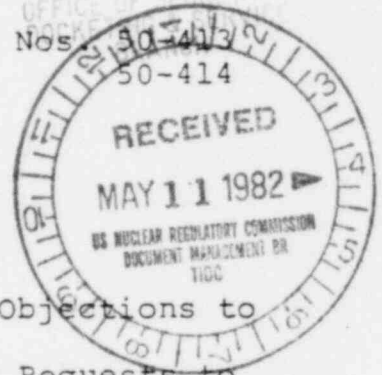

MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

On this date, May 10, 1982, Applicants filed Objections to Palmetto Alliance First Set of Interrogatories and Requests to Produce. These Objections, which are incorporated herein by reference, advance the position that answering discovery would be unusually burdensome by virtue of pending Objections to the Licensing Board's March 5, 1982 ruling on contentions. Applicants maintain that their pending Objections present the good cause required by the regulations and accordingly move, pursuant to 10 CFR §2.740(c), for a protective order that the discovery sought by Palmetto Alliance in its First Set of Interrogatories and Requests to Produce not be had until final resolution of the pending Objections to the Licensing Board's March 5, 1982 Order.


