MOTION TO ESTABLISH HEARING SCHEDULE

The undersigned respectfully moves that the Board establish a tentative schedule for hearing Mr. Reed's contentions and that such schedule be based upon the date that local plans are submitted to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for review.

DISCUSSION

It is recognized, by the undersigned, that plans submitted to F.E.M.A. are subject to alteration; however, it is felt that such plans are sufficiently firm in form and content that valid contentions can be elicited and properly formulated at that time. An order from the Board requiring Mr. Reed to delineate contentions prior to the plan being firmed sufficiently to be presented to F.E.M.A. will have the effect of requiring Mr. Reed to rewrite such plans for local government due to the many inadequacies that exist throughout current draft copies.

SUMMARY

Based upon the above discussion, it is respectfully requested that the Board prepare tentative schedules for hearings in the above captioned matter based upon a start time commensurate with the date local plans are submitted to F.E.M.A. for review and grant Mr. Reed reasonable time to meet the demands of the Board in submitting his contentions.


