Contention 3.2

We await reply to our interrogatory to the licensees.

Contention 3.3

We await opportunity to examine Parsons, Brinkerhoff, etc. studies. We can say now that we will use NUERG-0654 Rev.1 and Rockland County RERP using references in our Interrogatory of April 29.

Contention 3.9

Police Chief Michael Holland, Village of Havestraw, immediate past president Rockland County Chiefs of Police. Chief Holland will describe his department's responsibilities in relation to the roads and his experience moving traffic with respect to the roads. He has no documents.

Fred Seeger, Superintendant of Highways, Town of Clarkstown, 28 years experience, elected by all political parties. Same as Holland, above.

Chief of Sheriff Patrol James Kralik, same as Holland above. Chief Kralik will probably be offered as a Rockland County witness.

WBCA expects to offer additional such personnel as described in 3.3 above from other towns.

An official from the Rockland County Center For The Physically Handicapped WBCA will offer.

Mrs. Gladys Burger, President, Disabled In Action of Rockland County, WBCA witness. Mrs. Burger is surveying the facilities of the handicapped with regard to moving them in an emergency.

All the above will offer statistics from their records as exhibits attached to their testimony. They will illustrate how many handicapped are in the ten mile EPZ and what arrangements are made to move them, and what needs for movement are lacking, and what might be done toward improvement.

The estimate of Spanish speaking people is 6000 comprising approximately 1,950 families, see Exhibit D attached.

CENSUS TRACTS IN ROCKLAND COUNTY, N. Y.

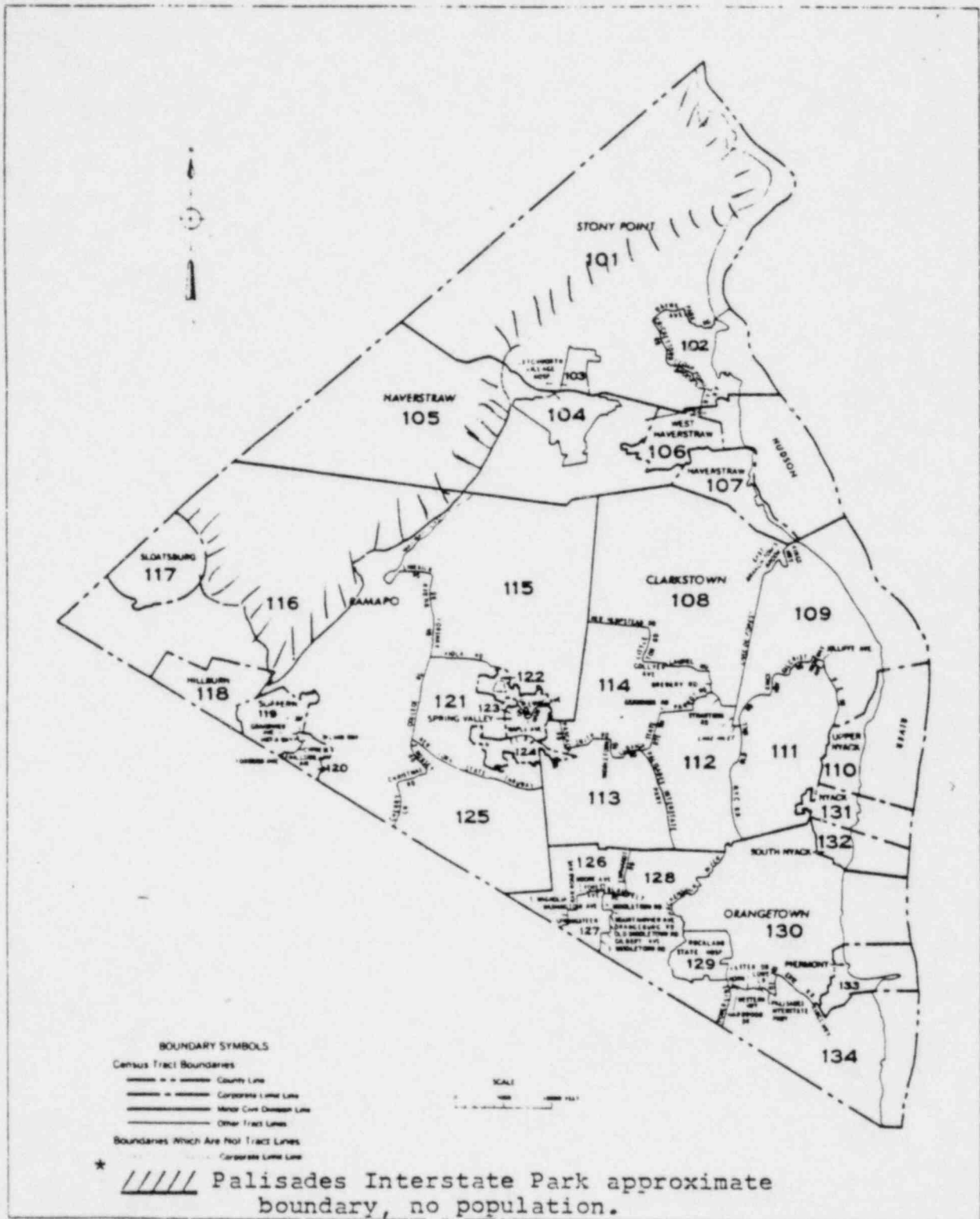
