

The Commonwealth's positions in the reopened proceeding on operator cheating were articulated in its proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law filed on January 18, 1982. Other than to reiterate these positions, the Commonwealth has no comments on the Special Master's Report or the partial preliminary ASLB opinion. The Commonwealth emphasizes that the introduction to its proposed findings and conclusions states that the absence of findings and conclusions on any issue should not be interpreted as agreement with the position of any party on that issue.


