CASE'S MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO REPLY TO
APPLICANTS' MOTION FOR SUMMARY DISPOSITION OF
CASE'S CONTENTION 5

Responses by CASE are due on Monday, May 31, which is a holiday. The Board has stated receipt on June 1 is acceptable. However, for CASE to mail the response in time -- given the Post Office is closed on May 31 -- must have the response ready on Saturday, May 29, before 3:30 P.M. when the Post Office closes.

Contention 5 is a very comprehensive and far-reaching contention. Applicants have responded with a 300-page motion for summary disposition which, under Section 2.749(a), CASE must respond to in detail or risk losing its right to litigate all or part of its contention.


If the Board denies "CASE's 5/20/82 Motion to Strike Applicants' Motion for Summary Disposition of CASE's Contention 5 for Late Filing," CASE moves for alternative relief in the form of further time in which to respond. Specifically, CASE requests an extension to permit CASE to mail its response by Express Mail on Wednesday, June 2, for arrival Thursday, June 3.

This extension means four additional days for CASE but only two days' delay for receipt by the other parties.

For the above and foregoing reasons, CASE moves the Board to extend the time for responding to Applicants' Motion for Summary Disposition of CASE's Contention 5 until June 3, 1982.


