

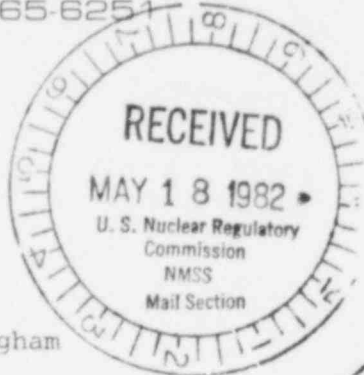

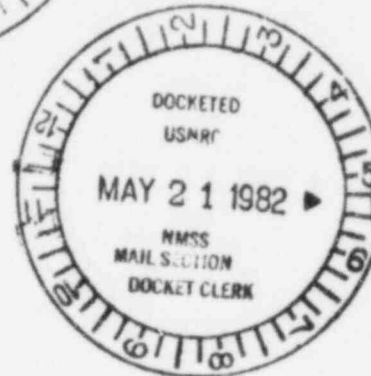

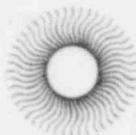
I am writing to confirm my conversation yesterday with Mr. Leland C. Rouse, Chief, Advanced Fuel and Spent Fuel Licensing Branch, concerning your letter of April 27, 1982 seeking the Authority's views on the Sierra Club's March 26, 1982 "show cause petition," which you are treating as a petition for reconsideration of Change No. 32 to License No. CSF-1. You had requested the Authority's views by May 17, 1982. I explained to Mr. Rouse that, due to extensive recent out-of-town travel and other unavoidable conflicts for Authority counsel in this matter, the Authority requested an extension of time until May 27, 1982, to respond to your request for comment. Counsel for Nuclear Fuel Services, Inc., the Authority's co-licensee, has no objection to the extension. Mr. Rouse stated that an extension until May 27th for the Authority's response was acceptable, but asked me to send this letter of confirmation to you.
