
Subject: Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station

Notification of Change to Protected Area

Our letters dated March 26, 1981 and July 8, 1981, reported temporary changes to the perimeter of the protected area due to the construction activities for the fire protection alternate water supply tank. These letters also indicated that upon completion of this construction, the protected area would be returned to its original state. On March 26, 1982, the restoration was effected, and the attached drawing shows the present location of the protected area fence.

Since the Security Plan contains information which, if released to the public, would compromise the physical security of the Oyster Creek Station, it is requested pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790 that this document be withheld from public disclosure.
