

The primary reason for Revision 13 is to incorporate the Unit 2 fuel storage building and the contaminated materials warehouse into the protected area. Revision 13 is being submitted pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(p) and does not decrease the effectiveness of the Security Plan.

Since this material is applicable to security provisions at McGuire, it is requested that this information be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 73.21.
