
The Final Environmental Statement for the OCNGS issued by the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission Directorate of Licensing in 1974 stated in Section 3.7.1 page 3-35 that domestic and sanitary wastes from the unrestricted nonradioactive areas of the plant are discharged to a packaged sewage treatment facility located at the station. The effluent from the station's packaged sewage treatment facility was subsequently regulated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency in the OCNGS National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit (Permit No. NJ 000 5550).
