4. Correspondence between the City of Phoenix and Salt River Project relating to the action filed by Salt River Project and R. J. McMullin against the City of Phoenix in the Superior Court of Maricopa County, Arizona, No. 200640, on May 24, 1967, which placed in issue the ownership and control over effluent from the 91st Avenue Wastewater Treatment Plant.

5. Correspondence since 1965 between the City of Phoenix and the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation regarding the use and disposition of sewage effluent and regarding the Supplement to Agreement between the Salt River Project and City of Phoenix dated December 30, 1969.




