JOINT NOTICE OF DEPOSITION

Please take notice that, pursuant to 10 CFR § 2.740a, Suffolk County ("SC") and Long Island Lighting Company ("LILCO") will each take the deposition upon oral examination, of the person(s), designated by each, who are competent to testify concerning the subject matters described below relating to SC Contentions 16 and 20. Such depositions will be held before a notary public or other officer duly authorized to administer oaths, commencing on the 22nd day of April, 1982, at the Dennison Building, Ninth Floor, Veterans Memorial Highway, Hauppauge, New York 11788, and continuing day to day thereafter until completed. The depositions concerning SC 16 will commence at 9:00 a.m.; those concerning SC 20 will commence at 1:30 p.m. With respect to each of the contentions, SC's deposition of LILCO witness(es) will take place first, to be followed by LILCO's deposition of SC witness(es).

The depositions will be taken for the purposes of discovery or evidence, or for other lawful purposes. SC intends to cover the following subjects:

SC 16

1. Design of the Standby Liquid Control System
 - (a) whether the SLCS meets single failure criteria
 - (b) whether the SLCS is redundant
 - (c) safety classification of the SLCS
2. Basis for responses to subjects covered in 1
3. Capability of the SLCS/mechanics (e.g., pump rate/flow rate; design rate of flow vs. that required for shutdown, etc.)
4. Reliance upon SLCS -- when it will be used
5. Procedures relating to SLCS use

SC 20

1. How LILCO intends to use the Dresden and Limerick simulators for Shoreham operator training prior to the availability of a Shoreham-specific simulator
2. Capabilities of the Dresden and Limerick simulators
3. Differences between the Shoreham control room and the Dresden and Limerick simulators
4. Provisions by LILCO to assure that Shoreham operator training will compensate for differences identified in response to 3
5. Who (identified by position or job description) will receive simulator training

You are invited to attend and cross-examine.


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
